The students loved finding out that this story is based on a real person. We had such great class discussion. The students completed their final EL assessment for the quarter and we are turning our focus to the upcoming Case 21 and Esperanza Book Assessment. I cannot wait to see all of the fun we have in Quarter 2 as we explore the Rainforest.

Math (Trainor)- We wrapped up Unit 2 this week and are now feeling strong about Order of Operations, Multiplying using the Area Model and Dividing larger numbers. Anyone who received a 2 on their Unit Test (coming home today) will work in a small group to allow more time for mastery. The Math Case 21 is on Tuesday, September 24th. Review videos, online games and practice problems are posted in Google Classroom, sorted by unit.
