What's going on in class?

Reading (Sullivan)- In Reading this week, we continued to read Esperanza rising while connecting it to the UDHR. We worked on quoting accurately when finding text evidence. We also spent time identifying the main idea of nonfiction text. When we return after track out we will have an assessment on main idea and quoting.

Math (Trainor)- Unit 1 Math Tests come home today. Please review with your child, sign the cover sheet and return to school after Track Out. If your child scored a 2 on any of the three standards assessed, he or she reviewed similar questions today in a small group with either Mrs. Priest (our amazing Math Intervention Teacher) or I. We will also practice more after Track Out. After Track Out, we will begin exploring Volume and multiplying multi-digit numbers up to thousands times tens and hundreds.

Social Studies (Trainor)- We wrapped up our Social Studies unit today by travelling through time to see how economic factors affected many important decisions throughout history. We pretended that we were immigrants in the 1800s, government officials just before the Civil War and modern-day barterers. We also proved that money DOES NOT grow on trees as we took time to think about our family members' careers and how even children can contribute to the family economy!

Science (Trainor) - Our Science unit will begin after Track Out and will explore Force & Motion! Lots of exciting new concepts which they previewed in STEM and Science specials the past three weeks, and we will continue to practice graphing.

AIG Nomination Window

If you would like your student considered for AIG testing they must first be nominated. This parent nomination must be in writing. It can be a handwritten note to their teacher or an email indicating you want them nominated. All nominations must be received by 4:15 on the last day of the nomination window. This allows us to prepare testing materials properly and schedule the needed testing sessions. First, we must schedule a School Based Committee for Gifted Education (SBCGE) meeting. At this meeting all nominations are discussed and the decision about whether testing is appropriate is made by the committee for each nominee. After that meeting, all testing materials are ordered and prepared individually for each student that will be testing. A testing schedule is then set up and parent reminders are created. *Students can only be tested once during a full calendar year. If your student was tested in the spring of 2019 they cannot best tested again until the spring of 2020.* *AIG testing for grades 4 and 5 only occurs two times a year. Once in the fall and once in the spring.*
