What's going on in class?

Reading (Sullivan)- We had such a fun week in Reading block! We started out the week celebrating Read Across America week with an escape room where we focused on the different ways Dr. Seuss used his growth mindset to become a successful author. This activity used out growth mindsets as well. Then we continued our study of Figurative Language. The students practiced writing their own examples as well as finding them in their text. By the end of the week we transitioned back to our study of Jackie Robinson. Next week we will finish up studying Jackie Robinson and take a post assessment that combines paragraph writing and identifying one of Jackie's factors of success.

Math (Trainor)- Today we took our Unit 6 Part 1 Post test. I will review them with students on Tuesday and send them home for you to review and sign on Tuesday. Unit 6 Part 2 dives into multiplying and dividing decimals and dealing with convertions in the Metric system. This takes lots of practice, so let's all brace for that!

Social Studies (Trainor)- Social Studies is on hold until Quarter 4 so that we can focus on Science.

Science (Trainor) - Each student is working on using Google Slides to take notes on our Weather unit, to prepare them not only for the Q3 Case 21 but also note taking during middle school classes. We discussed water cycle, severe weather and El Nino/ La Nina.

Science homework is assigned every Monday and is due on Friday. It is an article to read and respond to, and it is always posted in Google Classroom. We have far too many students not doing their Science homework, and I use homework strategically to support what we are doing in class. Please support your child's learning by ensuring he or she completes Science homework every week. Thank you!
