What's going on in class?

Reading (Sullivan)- In Reading this week, we spent a lot of time getting ourselves organized, setting expectations for independent reading. The students enjoyed their time to practice these expectations with a good book and being spread all around the classroom. We began to build some of the background we will need for the first unit of Reading through a webquest. Next week we will jump right into our new unit with a book study of *Esperanza Rising*.

Math (Trainor)- In Math this week, we set our Quarter 1 goals. We are using the website www.xtramath.org to help us solidify the fluency of our single-digit multiplication and division. Please review your child's goal with him/her and sign and return the Goal Sheet. Next week we will collect data, sort it into Categorical and Numerical data, and then discover how using line graphs can help us to better understand our data.

Social Studies (Trainor)- During Social Studies time, we began our Economics unit by reading about resources and how they affect businesses, families and individuals. We had some great discussions applying what we read to real life using vocabulary that includes: natural resource, capitol resource, human resource, surplus, scarcity, and interdependence. Next week we will learn about economic systems.
