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## What's going on in class?

**Reading (Sullivan)**- In Reading this week, we really dove into the our adventures with Esperanza. The kids have really enjoyed the story so far and are eager to read more and more. We have also begun to look at the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. We will be using that document to guide classroom discussions.

**Math (Trainor)**- This week we analyzed data about droughts and temperatures in NC, sorted it into Categorical and Numerical data, used line graphs to better understand trends in the data. We will continue to work on this typeof analysis next week by writing stories about what we see happening on line graphs. I hope to be able to administer the Unit 1 test on Thursday, but if we need to push it to Friday we will. We continue to use xtramath.org to work on our Math goals. We have three kiddos who have ALREADY met the Quarter 1 Math goal!! A NOTE ABOUT HOMEWORK: I send home one woeksheet each evening (Mondays- Thursdays) that is a review of what we did in class that day. If your child cannot complete the worksheet independently or with minimal support in less than twenty minutes, please let me know. I will sit with him or her the following morning to ensure that everyone is ready to roll into the next lesson!

**Social Studies (Trainor)**- Our Social Studies work has deepened our understanding of economics. We discussed specialization, e-commerce, production, consumption, division of labor and wealth. Next week we will firm up our understanding of this unit's concepts so that we can wrap up Economics for now (we revisit this unit in Quarter 4).

**Science (Trainor)** - Our Science unit will begin after Track Out and will explore Force & Motion!
