Reading (Sullivan)- This week in Reading we began a close study of nonfiction text structures. The students took a preassessment on Monday and we practiced reading and identifying all of the text structures through whole class lessons, independent practice, and small group assignments. The students will have their text structure post assessment on Monday. Then we will move into our study of the Rainforest. We also began reading the book *Hatchet* this week. The students are so excited to see how Brian survives his time in the wilderness.

Math (Trainor)- Unit 3 Part 1 tests are coming home today. This test assessed our understanding of multiplying fractions by whole numbers, fractions and mixed numbers. The most challenging part of this unit was understanding the concept that when we multiply a fraction by a whole number, the product will be less than the whole number. Extra practice activites are posted in Google Classroom marked, "Spiral review- unit 3 part 1". Next upexploring division and fractions!

Social Studies (Trainor)- We are busy diving deep into the Declaration of Independence! We've been partner reading, and hopping online to research this important document. Next week will create pretend Facebook pages about the Bill of Rights.

Science (Trainor) - The next Science unit will start in our 4th week of Quarter 2 when we begin exploring human body systems.
