What's going on in class?

Reading (Sullivan)- This week we took a break from our study of Jackie Robinson and began to turn our focus to Figurative Language. The kids always have a great time studying Figurative Language and learning the more creative ways they can say things. They are EXPERTS at spotting figurative language in the world around them. They have a weekend challenge of: if they see figurative language in something they read, see or hear and have their parent send me a Remind message (see below for how to join) they can earn extra clipper cash (if it is correctly identified, of course). Next week we will finish up Figurative Language and return to our study of the way Jackie Robinson shaped the world around us.

Math (Trainor)- This week we multiplied up to 3-digit whole numbers by 2-digit whole numbers (NBT 5) and dividing- with remainders- whole numbers with up to 4-digit dividends and 2-digit divisors using various methods (NBT 6). I have posted review videos in Google Classroom under a post entitled "Unit 6 Part 1 Spiral Review". We will have a test on this next week- a study guide will come home on Monday.
